- Assist in preparing and submitting applications (writing or compiling required documents)
- Help gather necessary information from within the team (budgets, reports, testimonials, etc.)
- 3. Develop Fundraising Materials
- Support the creation of templates, proposals, and standard documents for repeated use
- Help tailor applications to funder requirements
- 4. Database & Tracking
- Maintain a record of funding opportunities, deadlines, submissions, and outcomes
- Assist in tracking donor or sponsor engagement
- 5. Liaison & Communication
- Help build and maintain positive relationships with potential funders
- Draft or review correspondence where needed

- Attention to detail and ability to follow application guidelines
- Research and organisational skills

- Interest in community development, family support, or non-profit work
- Funding/Grant experience is a bonus but not essential
